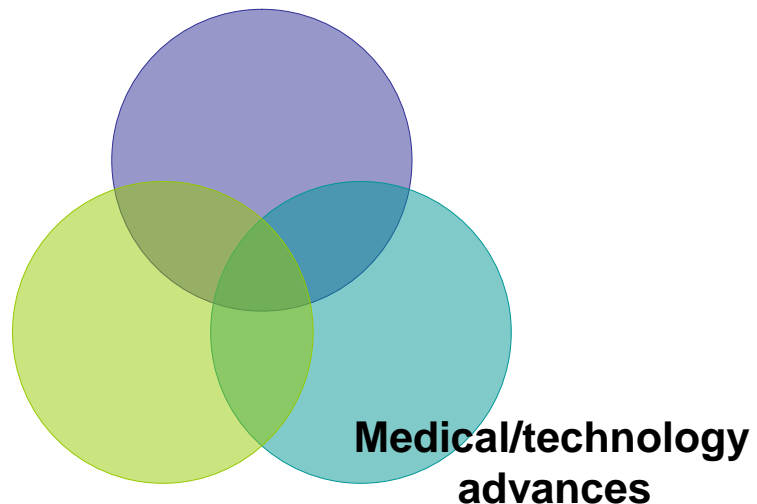
- Ageing health workforce

Patients



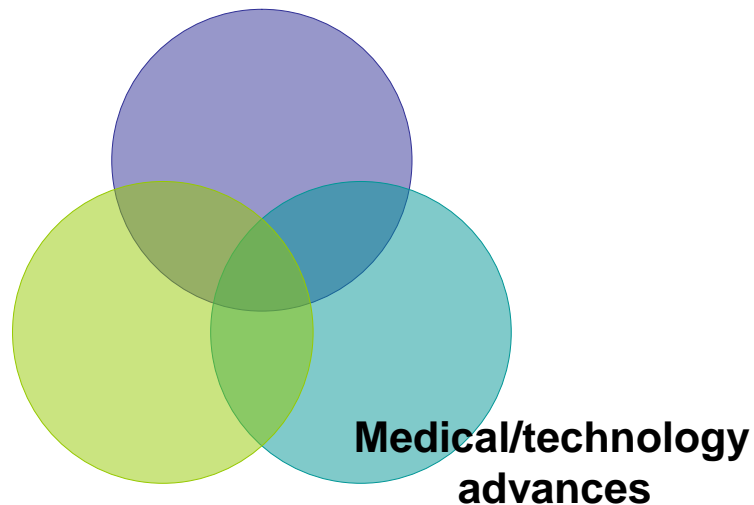
- Better informed

The Juncture: Risks



- Is it a proven technique/treatment?
- Patient selection
- Appropriate care delivery
- Loss of chance
- Training/competency

Risks: proven treatment?

- Nature of medicine – new techniques tried/trialled; many years until empirical evidence available
- Unintended consequences of treatment
- Price pressures from manufacturers of new technology on doctors and hospitals

Risks: Patient selection

- Consumer demand – eg fertility treatment
- Price incentives (private sector) – eg GPs and cosmetics; surgeons and lap-banding
- Defensive medicine – fear of patient ‘reprisal’
- Informed Consent

Risks: Appropriate care delivery

- Is it the right person/mix of people delivering the right procedure to the right patient at the right location?
- Breadth and depth of skills
- Care delivery cost drivers – high input/high return procedures

Risks: Loss of opportunity

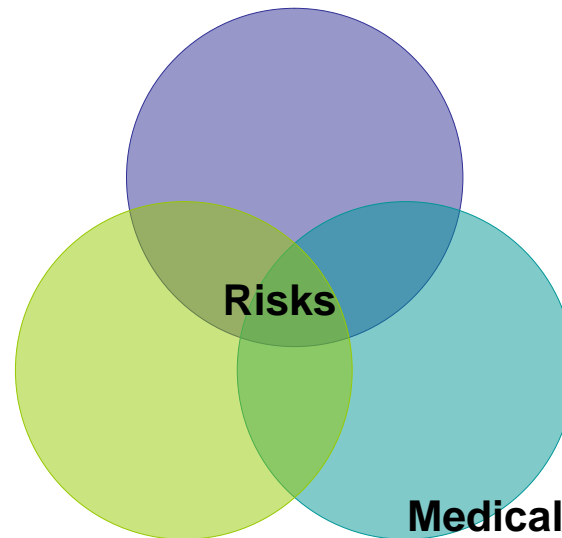
- Primary prevention.....If informed of medication/procedure and provided with the treatment could have prevented current ailment.....
- Resource implications
eg dialysis, intraocular lens, joint prosthesis

Risks: training/competency

- Medical school outputs
- Training opportunities – impact on quality and breadth/depth of skills acquired?
- Task Substitution
- Teamwork
